A pleasant surprise was the large number of students who came to Stress Release. We are using mindfulness training, meditation and even aromatherapy to help reduce stress levels. We are increasing the frequency of these options to keep up with the demand.

The Student Center has also been busy orchestrating PGP activities to meet the youth development needs of our students. We have partnered with Prevent Child Abuse NJ to bring a special workshop for your young men. This four part training focuses on how to become the kind of man who is aware of social

pressures, is strong enough to resist negative influences, and demonstrates respect for all genders. Our young women are involved in My Life, My Choice, a ten-part workshop focusing on the prevention of victimization, as well as empowerment to be assertive and resistant to negative influences.




