Successful providers will also be required to present a) proof of liability insurance – minimum of \$2M in coverage, with the Hoboken Board of Education named as Additional Insured – and b) evidence of successful criminal history background checks for "person serving in a position which involves regular contact with pupils" as per NJSA 18A:6-7.1. The contract, if awarded, shall be awarded to the Professional Service Provider who submits a response which is deemed to provide for the highest quality of service at a fair and competitive price which is most advantageous to the Board, price and other factors considered, for the contract period commencing December 4th, 2023 and concluding on June 6, 2023.
