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Summer Math Assignments for Students Entering Grades 1-5

June 15, 2018

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Caregivers,

Students will have the opportunity to engage with mathematics throughout the summer months. Prior to the close of the school year, teachers identified areas of growth that students will work on throughout the summer utilizing Edmentum for students entering grades 1 through 5. It is our belief that implementing this program will provide students with the skills necessary to be academically ready in the area of mathematics in September. Students Rising in Grades 1-3 will utilize the Exact Path Program in Edmentum. Students entering Grades 4 & 5 will utilize the Edmentum Program as they did last summer. Below referenced are the expectations of minutes students entering Grades 1-3 must complete by September 6, 2018. Additionally, students in Grades 4 & 5 will be required to complete a number of activities per the prescriptions as evidenced by their final Edmentum Assessment given to them in April, 2018. The Edmentum prescriptions for students entering Grades 4 & 5 must be completed by September 6, 2018.

Entering Grade 1: 180 Minutes of Exact Path Mathematics Enrichment

Entering Grades 2 & 3: 270 Minutes of Exact Path Mathematics Enrichment

Entering Grades 4 & 5: 10 Activities within the Edmentum Module

Directions on how to access Exact Path Enrichment Activities for students Entering Grades 1-3 are attached to this correspondence. Directions how to access Edmentum Prescriptions are also attached to this correspondence for students Entering Grades 4 & 5. Additionally, directions how to access both the Exact Path and Edmentum Modules are available via the district website at www.hoboken.k12.nj.us. Once on the district website page, you will have to click Curriculum to Summer Assignments to find the directions in PDF form. Parents, guardians, and caregivers will be able to view the growth of their child throughout the summer as they work on these mathematics modules.

For students entering Grades 1 through 5, they are encouraged to take part in the Summer Math Lab Opening throughout the summer if support is needed. The math lab is not mandatory. We will have certified teachers on-site to provide support to your child as they work towards completion of their summer mathematics assignment. The math lab will operate Tuesdays through Thursdays beginning July 30th through August 24th in Room 302 between the hours of 3:00 PM-5:00 PM at Wallace Elementary School.

Students are aware of their usernames and passwords. Teachers will give their students a copy of their individual username and password. If your child forgets either their username or password, each school clerk will have this information in order to give it to you. Also, the math lab teacher will have this information for the students as well once the lab is open for summer assistance.
